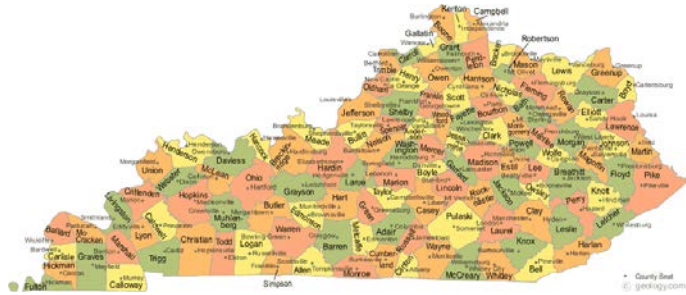

KENTUCKY – CLIMATE

Located within the southeastern interior portion of North America, Kentucky has a climate that can best be described as a [humid subtropical climate](#) (Koppen *Cfa*). Temperatures in Kentucky usually range from daytime summer highs of 87 °F (31 °C) to the winter low of 23 °F (−5 °C). The average precipitation is 46 inches (1,200 mm) a year.^[15]

Kentucky experiences four distinct seasons, with substantial variations in the severity of summer and winter.^[16] The highest recorded temperature was 114 °F (46 °C) at [Greensburg](#) on July 28, 1930 while the lowest recorded temperature was −37 °F (−38 °C) at [Shelbyville](#) on [January 19, 1994](#).
